VIOLIN

- Students should be prepared to play 1 major scale (no arpeggios), 2 octaves, up to three flats and three sharps: C, G, D, A, F, Bb, Eb. (Scale selected by the judge.) **All scales must be memorized.** Each scale tone should be equal to at least 90 beats per minute on a metronome.
- Prepared piece below
- Sight reading.
- Students who would like to move up to Sinfonia must play the requirements and audition music for both Sinfonia and Philharmonia.
- \$15 audition charge, \$10 for additional students within the same family, due at the time of audition.
